The Lake George Park Commission has implemented a mandatory boat inspection and decontamination program as part of an Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Spread Prevention Program for Lake George.

Please help protect Lake George from the introduction of new AIS, and plan ahead for mandatory boat inspections.

Get on the water faster. Arrive Clean, Drained, & Dry.









Save time and get out on the water faster. Arrive at the inspection station:



Clean and remove all visible plants, animals, fish, and mud from your boat, trailer, or other equipment.



Drain water from motor, bilge, live wells, ballast tanks, storage compartments and any other locations.



Dry your boat, trailer, and all equipment including bumpers, ropes, and anchors.

Regional Inspection Stations

As of May 15, 2014 all trailered vessels must be inspected and sealed at a regional inspection station prior to launching on Lake George.
